## About the College

Government College Barwala, Panchkula established on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 1993 stands as one of the oldest colleges in Panchkula and its nearby districts. It is situated in the rural area of village Barwala. The institution prides itself on fostering self-discipline and a strong work ethic among its students. With a vision to become a premier institution of higher learning, it is dedicated to providing quality education to rural students while instilling values of social responsibility, academic excellence, and open-mindedness. Committed to offering opportunities for skill development, the college aims to equip students to become competent, self-reliant, and socially conscious individuals.

Spread across 9 acres of picturesque land, the sprawling campus of this college boasts a heavenly landscape adorned with fruit trees, colorful flowers, and a serene Herbal Park. This college has been a beacon of education since its establishment in 1993, illuminating not only the urban and rural areas of Panchkula but also the adjoining towns of Punjab. Our College offers four Bachelor's Courses-Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Computer Application, and Bachelor of Physical Science and affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

## Student Body

## Staff

## College Library

Our college has an outstanding library streamlined through the implementation of Integrated Library Management Software (ILMS) SOUL 3.0. The library is equipped with more than 9,000 books in varied subjects like English, Hindi, Punjabi, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Commerce, Computer Science, Political Science, Geography, History, Physical Education etc. It has a collection of both text and reference books. Library is fully air conditioned with the facility of inverter. In the Session 2023-24, this college has utilized grant for making library more amiable for its visitors. In the current academic session 2023-24, government has allocated Rs.200,000/ (2 Lacs) meant for strengthening the college library. This grant has been successfully utilized for the purchase of 5KVA inverter, luminous battery, Books and Furniture. The library has membership of INFLIBNET, for facilitating the availability of unlimited number of journals in every branch of study. Annual subscription of N-List from INFLIBNET has also been renewed for 2024-25. N-List subscription makes college library rich in accessing e-resources (e-resources and e-books). College library has sitting capacity of more than 50 in reading room. Facility of reading room and digital lounge for teachers and students provide an academic amiable space to pursue their academic goals.



### **Scholarships and Stipends**

In the current session, under Consolidated Stipend Scheme and Free Books Scheme for SC Students. 66 SC students were provided an amount of Rs. 2000 for books and stipend of Rs.1000 per student for 12 months. 29 students benefited from the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for OBC and 4 students get benefitted through Haryana state meritorious incentive scheme.
