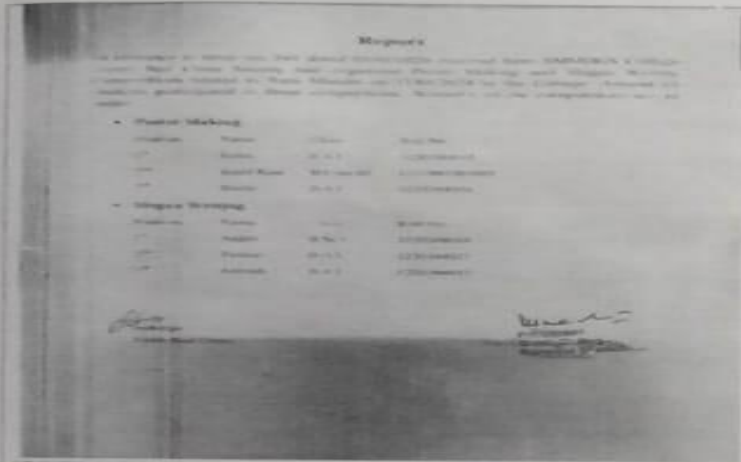
Red-Ribbon Club Activities





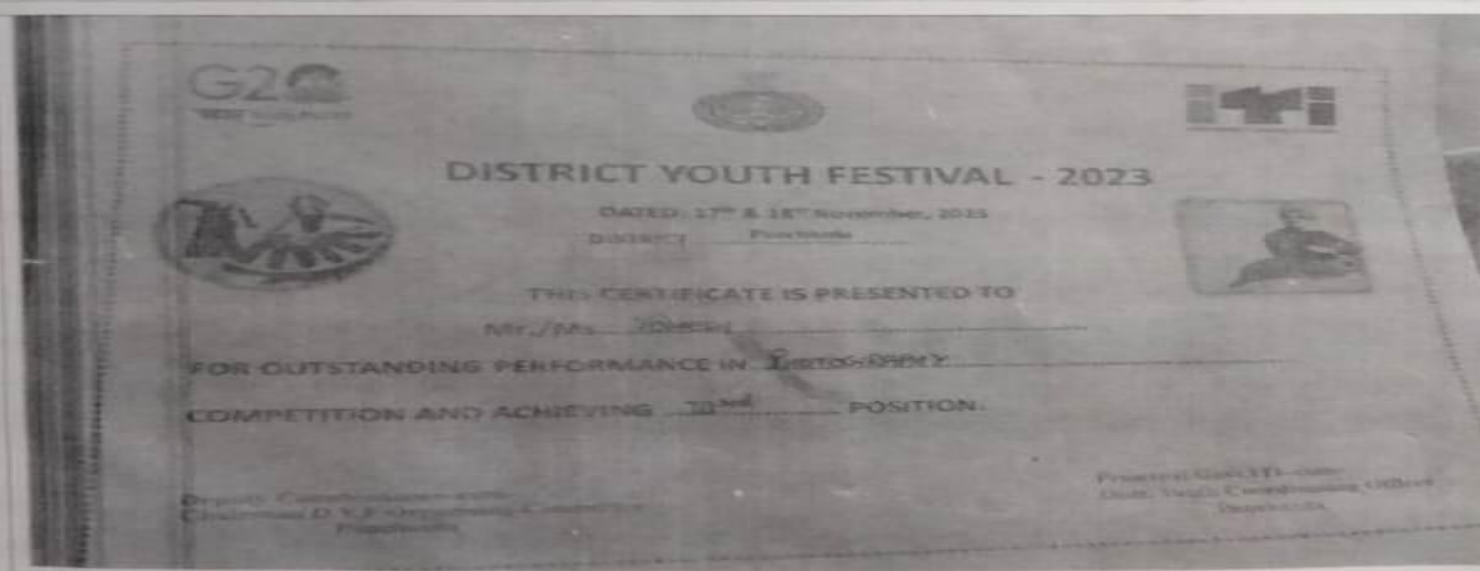




Participated in District Youth Festival-2023
